Volunteer with a Trail Crew!

We have some great opportunities to learn from experienced trail crews and practice the skills taught in our Trail Building 101 series.

Volunteers are welcome to join the work crews at 10 AM or 1 PM and work as many hours as they like.

July 20, 21, 22

Weber Kelly Preserve, Georgetown. Work alongside a field team from The Nature Conservancy removing invasive species, GPSing boundary lines, installing boundary markers and trail signs.

July 23

Green Point Preserve, West Bath. Activities include GPSing boundary lines and building bog bridges.

August 5 - 8

Whiskeag Trail, Bath. A team from the Maine Conservation Corps is building new trail behind the Middle School, and a new section entering Sewall Woods as part of a 5-mile long trail connecting the YMCA to Thorne Head.

August 10 - 14

Thorne Head and Sewall Woods, Bath. Maine Conservation Corps and The Nature Conservancy Field Team will be building bog bridges and repairing sections of well used trail.

What to Bring: Please bring water, a lunch and tools (gloves, loppers, shovels, clippers) and bug spray. It's recommended that you wear a hat, long sleeves, pants, and work boots.

Weather: Hard rain and thunderstorms will cancel the work day.
